
Who is a Senior Citizen in Israel

A senior citizen is defined by the age of retirement:


62 for women, 67 for men.



Life Expectancy in Israel




Percentage of Israel's senior population age 65 or over



Long term care:

Long term care:

One-fifth of the Israeli Senior Citizens are entitled to the Nursing Act 160,000 of 800,000

Only 4% in Long-term care institutions.

The average duration of long term care grew rapidly from 18 months to 42 months in 20 years.



Volunteer program

Empowerment of voluntary organizations for recruitment and activation of volunteers for one million hours of volunteer work a month by senior citizens.

Placement and employment Centers

Development of diverse employment solutions for senior citizens which suit their will, professional background and personal skills, through placement in the open market and by development of occupational frameworks suited for senior citizens.

Incorporation of the senior citizen population as the largest active consumer force in the country

*8840 Call Center

A call center for senior citizen issues which provides information and assistance in dealing with government offices and various organizations in a variety of fields: senior citizen rights, health, The National Insurance Institute, housing, welfare, pension, consumerism, culture and leisure, and more. 210,000 calls have been received by the call center thus far.
